

***Macbeth* Newspaper Project**

This project is an individual assignment and is worth a total of 60 points (about the same as a test grade)! All class periods will turn their newspapers in on **Monday, December 2 at the beginning of your class**; if the project is not on your desk at the beginning of class, it is late.

Your assignment is to create a newspaper for Act _____ of *Macbeth*. Imagine you are a reporter living in Macbeth's Scotland. What significant events occur in your act that would be important to report on? In order to receive 60 points, you will want to follow the rubric very carefully! Each newspaper will include...

- TWO News articles—At least 350 words each
- ONE Feature article—At least 450 words
- ONE Editorial or Letter to the Editor—At least 500 words
- Images and captions for each article

Extra credit can be earned for including additional elements from a newspaper—advice columns, comics, cartoons, additional articles, advertisements, et cetera. Your newspaper should look like a newspaper but you can be a bit creative with this!

If you need help clarifying newspaper-related vocabulary, check the handout provided. If you want a great grade to give you a boost going into finals, **WORK HARD!** Students who leave this project to the last moment will not do as well as those who have planned ahead!
